Assist with filling out applications

Make sure students & families have the necessary documents

Make time to address concerns for students who seem hesitant

Regularly follow up with every Senior to make sure their applications are complete

Promote college going culture

Provide classroom time for financial aid presentations & stress the importance of a college education

Organize & plan financial aid events with school administration

Talk to parents about the requirement at Back to School Night

Incentivize Early Completion

Give recognition to students who have completed their application

Plan a financial aid completion success party hosted by student leaders

Keep track of student progress

Track your progress using WebGrants Reports
