#### **Award Year 2010-11**

The following data in this report were revised:

- CCC Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant A and B recipients, and
- Competitive Eligible Non-recipients.

#### **Award Years 2011-12 and 2012-13**

The data in this report reflect all applicants who qualified for either an Entitlement or Competitive Cal Grant. A qualified applicant may be attending or planning to attend an eligible or ineligible Cal Grant school in award years 2011-12 and 2012-13. Only qualified applicants offered a new Cal Grant and attending an eligible Cal Grant school will be able to receive payment.

Schools or postsecondary institutions seeking to participate in the Cal Grant Program must meet various eligibility requirements in law. Two required thresholds were added to the law for schools to meet in order to receive Cal Grants.

- In the 2011-12 award year, each institution's federal student loan three-year Cohort Default Rate (CDR) had to meet the threshold specified in law to be an eligible Cal Grant school.
- Beginning with the 2012-13 award year, each institution's CDR and graduation rate had to meet the respective thresholds specified in law to be an eligible Cal Grant school.
